



YouthLink Household Essentials Kit Assembly Guide

The journey to stability doesn't end when a young person is housed. YouthLink case managers continue supporting youth as they transition into and maintain their housing. During check-ins, case managers often bring basic household supplies that help youth keep their living space clean, comfortable, and functional. These everyday items can make a big difference for young people who are working toward stability and might not have the resources to purchase household essentials.

Suggested items for Basic Household Needs kits:

- 1–2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 small pack of toilet paper (1–6 rolls)
- Dish soap
- 1–2 sponges
- All-purpose cleaner spray
- Disinfecting wipes (such as Clorox wipes)
- Garbage bags
- Laundry pods or laundry detergent

Additional donations can be added if they fit within this category, including:

- Glass cleaner
- Scrub brush
- Microfiber cleaning cloths or rags
- Air freshener
- Aluminum foil or plastic wrap
- Zip-top storage bags
- Fabric softener or dryer sheets
- Hand soap

Please ensure all items fit within one container, and are easy to carry, such as:

- A reusable grocery bag, or
- A small storage bin
